**Enterprise Awards \$10,000 to Las Vegas Urban League**

*Enterprise Holdings ROAD Forward and Las Vegas Urban League  
Advancing Social and Racial Equity in Clark County, NV, USA*

**LAS VEGAS (July 28, 2022)** - The Las Vegas Urban League received \$10,000 from Enterprise Holdings Foundation to advance social and racial equity in Clark County, NV.

The contribution is a piece of the Enterprise Holdings ROAD Forward commitment to allocate \$35 million to more than 70 global Enterprise operating teams to drive local impact, as part of its broader commitment to donate \$55 million over five years to organizations that advance social and racial equity in the communities where it operates.

In presenting the donation, Tony Bourne, Replacement & Leisure Sales Manager of the Replacement & Leisure Division in the Nevada Group, said, "We are proud to support the Las Vegas Urban League in its commitment to empower communities and ensure equal opportunity for low-income citizens.

"As a company, Enterprise Holdings is committed to advancing diversity, equality and inclusion in the communities where we live and work. Las Vegas Urban League is a key player in that mission through its work to enhance early childhood development, youth health and wellness, and career and college preparation," Bourne added.

The local grants program empowers employees to take the lead on identifying organizations that are best equipped to address social and racial equity gaps in their own communities across three areas:

- Early childhood development
- Youth health and wellness, and
- Career and college preparation

Andrea Fleming, Director of Human Resources for the Las Vegas Urban League, said, “It is wonderful to once again receive this generous grant from Enterprise Holdings. This \$10,000 will enable Urban League to expand its programs to target social and economic issues faced by low-income and minority residents of Clark County and its outlying areas.”

In the second year of this program, Enterprise Holdings awarded local ROAD Forward grants to nearly 700 nonprofits addressing social and racial equity gaps facing youth and families in local communities. This year’s grants bring Enterprise’s total allocation in 2021 and 2022 to approximately \$34 million across both local (\$14 million) and national (\$20 million) nonprofits. In August of 2021, Urban League received a \$10,000 Enterprise Road Forward Grant.

The Las Vegas Urban League Early Childhood Connection (ECC) and Las Vegas Urban League Women, Infants and Children (WIC) programs are 501c (3) programs funded by the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services Division of Public Health.
